

Rules and Information

- Be on time. Have your players ready to go. We want to stay on schedule as much as possible, but games may start early. The umpires will be working hard to keep the games on schedule.
- Tournament Directors is Jason Grigg (308)340-1248.
- Umpire-in-Charge is Tony Castillo. (308)627-5086
- Game balls will be provided by the Optimist Club.
- This is an ASA sanctioned event. ASA rules apply unless otherwise specified.
- Umpires are ASA registered.
- Umpire decisions are final and no protests will be allowed.
- Coin flip will determine the home team.
- All games will be played with an open home plate.
- 12U & 14U Division: A time limit of one hour 15 minutes will apply with the clock starting on the coin flip.
- 10U Division: Maximum of 8 runs per at-bat plus one run for each out not recorded. Game will end at 75 minutes. If home team has not been given chance to win when time expires, final score will be based on last fully-completed inning.
- A game may end in a tie.
- Run rule 12 after 3 innings, 8 after 5 innings.
- Free substitution and all players will be included in the batting order.
- Official scorekeeper will be the home team.
- Medals will be given to players for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in all divisions. Ties will be broken in this respective order: 1) head to head results, 2) fewest runs allowed, 3) most runs scored, and 4) coin flip.
- Roster players and 3 coaches will be admitted free of charge.
- Admission price for spectators: \$5 adult, \$3 student.
- Concessions will be available.
